We are pleased to inform you that the design for the new Maggie's centre at the Royal Free Hospital is nearly finalised, and the planning application has been approved by Camden Council.

Maggie's provide drop-in centres across the UK which are available to help anyone with cancer, their families and friends. They create caring and homely environments set in beautiful landscapes providing professional support, information and practical advice.

The duration of the works for the new centre at the Royal Free Hospital site is currently forecasted at 54 weeks, starting in the spring / summer of 2021. More detail on this can be found in the Construction Management Plan (CMP). The CMP shows the proposed durations for each phase of works to the building and landscaping, the site layout, and logistics including deliveries.

The CMP will be available in this location as a live document throughout construction. To keep everyone informed, updates and current descriptions of construction milestones will also be displayed on the site hoarding which will be able to be seen from the Royal Free Hospital's south carpark.
